

HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

It is agreed that the school will:

- Provide a high standard of academic education, in order to prepare pupils for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of adult life
- Provide a wide range of extra-curricular activities of a sporting, cultural and creative nature
- Provide a caring community in which the needs of individual pupils are served and personal relationships may flourish

- Keep parents regularly informed of their child's progress via reports and Parents' Evenings
- Consult parents if necessary at other times at an early stage to prevent the escalation of problems
- Provide a welcoming atmosphere for parents and pupils to consult staff and to become involved in the lie of the school
- Consult parents as required on school policy

- Endeavour to achieve the highest academic standards
- Behave appropriately in relation to pupil Code of Conduct and Behaviour Policy
- Have excellent uniform, attendance, punctuality and commitment to school life
- Complete homework and classwork with maximum effort and diligence
- Bring all the equipment required to school for each day

It is agreed that parents/carers will support the school by:

- Encouraging the highest standards of academic study
- To treat members of staff, teaching and support, in a courteous manner
- Ensuring your child attends regularly and punctually, observing national requirements on attendance and notification of absence
- Supporting school policies and guidelines of behaviour
- Seeing that your child complies with school regulations currently in force, especially with regard to uniform, equipment and the school library
- Letting the school know of any concerns or problems which might affect your child's work or behaviour
- Attending Parents' Evenings and other discussions about your child's progress
- Getting to know about and becoming involved in your child's life at school
- Encouraging your child to complete a Sixth Form course if s/he is likely to derive educational benefit from doing so

It is agreed that parents/carers AND pupils will support the school with its approach to:

- E-safety and not upload or post to the internet any pictures, videos or text that could upset, offend or threaten the safety of any member of the school, community or bring the school into disrepute
